Fellow of the Society for Reproductive Biology and Comparative Endocrinology (FRE) Guidelines and Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Conferred on Life Members of the SRBCE of a minimum of five years standing and who have been regularly participating in the activities of the Society.
- 2. Only FREs of the Society can nominate and second candidates for the award for FRE. The nominator should ensure that the nominee fulfils all requirements and that he/she is an active member of the Society.
- 3. The nominee Should have PhD in the subject
- 4. Should have a minimum of 15 years of Teaching / Research experience
- 5. Must have published at least 25 research papers in reputed and referred national and international journals; at least 12 should be in reputed journals.
- 6. To collect Rs. 3000/- (Rupees Three thousand only) as enrolment fee for the nomination of FRE
- 7. Duly filled Nominations in the prescribed proforma with the nominee's attainments, achievements and reprints of top five publications in the area of research to be considered for the award.
- 8. Restricted to the maximum of two awrdss for a year as amended during 1997
- 9. The nominee should submit his/her nomination with (i) detailed bio-data, (ii) a List of publications in peer-reviewed journals in the area of research to be considered for the award with citation, H index, i10-Index and impact factors, (iii) a write up of about 500 words about his/her achievement in the selected area (iv) copies of their top five research publications in the area of research to be considered for the award.
